Choice Based Credit System Under Graduate Course for the Session 2022-23

About Under Graduate CBCS...

The Undergraduate (UG) programme in the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) is the course spread across six-semesters of any Under Graduate Course. The course will be of six semesters covering three calendar years (Academic session from June to May). The duration of Odd semesters (1st, 3rd and 5th) shall be June-November, and that of even semesters (2nd, 4th and 6th) shall be December- May. The courses in Gauhati University (GU) - CBCS are categorized primarily into three types of courses - Core, Elective and Ability/ Skill Enhancement Courses. All the core and elective courses will comprise of 6 credits and Ability / Skill courses are of 4 credits.

Core Course:

A Core Course is a necessary course that a student must take in order to complete the degree. The number of core courses for Honors and Regular degrees are different.

Elective Course:

An Elective Course is the one for which a student has some kind of freedom to choose from a pool of courses. There are two kinds of elective courses- Generic and Discipline specific. The Generic Courses are those which can be chosen by a student belonging to any stream, while the discipline specific elective courses are particular to only the discipline concerned.

Ability / Skill Enhancement Course:

An Ability or Skill Enhancement Course is aimed at providing the student with skill and ability. The Ability Enhancement Courses must be opted by a student and the student can choose papers from a pool of Skill Enhancement Courses. Students can also choose online course offered through the Study Webs of Active Learning for Young Aspiring Minds (SWAYAM) portal. https://swayam.gov.in/

Dissertation / Project:

A student can opt (Subject to conditions) a dissertation or a project work in-lieu of a 6 credits Discipline Specific Elective course in the Sixth Semester.

Credit:

A student needs to earn a required number of credits in order to successfully complete a degree. The credit is closely related to the number of stipulated classes a student has to complete. The following table indicates the number of credits a student can earn.

- 3. Selection of applicants will be made as per merit.
- 4. A student desirous of offering a subject as Major Course must secure at least 50% marks in the concerned subject in HS level. It is compulsory for the student to qualify in the selection test conducted by the respective department. (For the current academic session selection will be made on merit basis only)
- 5. Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD applicant will be maintained as per Govt. rules.
- 6. Students pursuing as Honours degree course can choose a Generic Elective from any other discipline except from the honours course itself.
- 7. Subject choiced at the time of Admission cannot be changed afterwards.

Examination and Evaluation:

- The pass marks in each paper is 30% of total marks in that paper (external + internal).
- ❖ A student who fails in one or more papers should repeat the papers by attending all the classes and by appearing for internal as well as external examinations at the next opportunity. A student shall get three chances for clearing the papers within six years from the date of admission to the degree programme.
- To pass in a course / paper, a student has to pass in both Internal Assessment and End Semester Examination separately.
- No student will be allowed to appear in the ' first and fifth' and 'second and sixth' semester examinations simultaneously.
- ❖ Internal Assessment marks will be 20% of a paper. The details of Internal Assessment marks are given below.

Admission Procedure and General Rule

- ❖ Information regarding fees Structure will be notified in the College website before Admission dated as per latest Govt. Guidelines.
- Entire admission process will be conducted on-line for the academic session 2022-23.
- Students have to upload scanned copies of Mark sheets, Certificates and all other relevant documents for the admission process. Authenticity of uploaded documents will be verified by college authority if needed.
- Students have to upload bank details including IFSC Code, Bank Name and Branch and mobile number to avail the benefit of any type of applicable govt. schemes.

Eligibility to Appear in the Examination:

- The students must have at least 75% attendance in lectures delivered in each of the subjects opted by them.
- > Students are required to obtain a minimum 25% mark in the aggregate of all subjects in the Sessional Examination.
- > Leave must be applied in advance duly countersigned by parents/guardian.
- In case of serious illness, the leave application must be submitted within a week along with Medical Certificate. Otherwise lectures will not be granted for Medical Leave or any other leave taken by the students. The leave only ensures that the student's name is not struck off and remains on the college rolls.
- Failing to fulfill any of the given conditions, the student will not be able to appear in Gauhati University Examination.
- ➤ Wearing prescribed uniform in the college is compulsory for all students.
- Use of Mobile Phone inside the college is subject to permission from the college authority.
- Appearing Sessional, Terminal, and Test Examinations is compulsory for all students.
- All Examination Rules of Gauhati University are strictly enforced in the Final/ Sessional Examinations.



Dear Parents and Students

Students Engagement

NSS (National Service Scheme):

Students are encouraged in participating in NSS (National Service Scheme) activities organized by the NSS unit. NSS unit of Behali Degree College was formed during the session 2014-15. NSS is sponsored by Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) to train the youth in Community Service. 
