NEP-2020 (FYUGP)

Under Graduate Course for the Session 2025-26

About NEP-2020 (FYUGP)

A **Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP)** with multiple entries and exits. In this programme, one has the choice to exit from the programme thrice – after one year, after two years and after three years.

Progression:

In FYUGP, students get a Bachelor Degree with Major after 3 years and a degree with Major & Honours or a degree with Honours with Research after 4 year. If a student exits the FYUGP after 3 years, she/he will need to take admission into the first year of a Master's programme, which is a 2-year Master degree programme. However, if a student fully completes an FYUGP, she/he needs to take admission into the second year of a Master's programme and needs to complete only one year to get a Master Degree. Once a student takes admission into a Master's programme either after 3 years of the Bachelor's programme or after FYUGP, one will be able to take admission into a Doctoral programme leading to the Degree of PhD. However, if a student is exceptionally good, one can directly take admission into a Doctoral programme right after the FYUGP, bypassing the Master's programme.

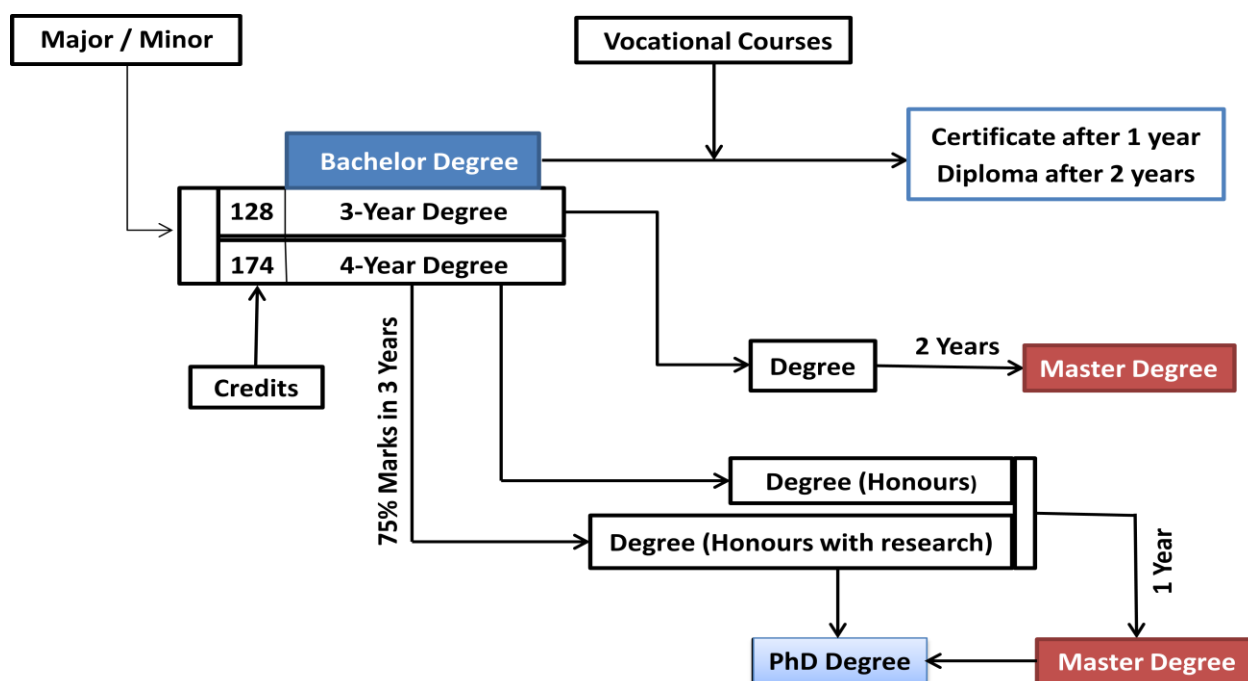


Figure: Progression under FYUGP (Madhabdev University)



About Courses

Basically, there are two parts of a course under the FYUGP – (a) Core Courses and (b) Common Courses. As the name suggests, different students study different core courses and all students study the common courses. The minimum credit allocation for a 3-year programme is 66 credits in Core Courses and 62 credits in Common Courses, which comes to a total of minimum 128 credits for a 3-year programme. With the fourth year, the minimum credit requirement becomes 174.

Core Courses:

The Core Courses determine the ultimate degree, diploma, or certificate a student will earn at the end of third (or fourth) year, second year, or first year, respectively. The Core Courses have to be chosen among a plethora of subjects offered for both the types of degrees, respectively. In case of a Bachelor's Degree in a Stream, the components of the Core Courses are Major and / or Minors. Usually, for majority of the students, the Core Course will consist of one Major and one Minor.

Common Courses:

The common courses are to be studied by all students alike and all-together they carry total credits of 34 over a 3-year period. These courses are further divided into following sub-categories:

Multi-disciplinary Course (MDC): These are 3-credit courses spanning over different groups of subjects.

Ability Enhancement Course (AEC): An Ability Enhancement Course is aimed at providing the student with skill and ability. The Ability Enhancement Courses must be opted by a student and the student can choose papers from a pool of Skill Enhancement Courses. This is an 8-credit course in total covering Language/ Alternative English and English Usage (Communication).

Skill Enhancement Course (SEC): These are various skill courses with total credit allocation of 10. All students need to complete three skill courses during Semesters 1-3.

Value Added Course (VAC): The VAC courses will come from various sub groups comprises of Introduction to Yoga, NSS & Youth development, Sports & Physical Education, Primary skills on Rover & Ranger and Environmental Studies. All together they will have a credit allocation of 7. Each student will have to take any three courses from any three groups during Semesters 1, 2, & 3.

Internship: All students are to carry out an Internship with a credit allocation of 4. The internship is expected to be carried out in Semester 4 & 5. The internships are meant to be done during semester breaks they will not interfere with other classes.

Research Project: A student can opt (Subject to conditions) a dissertation or a project work of 2 credits in the Sixth Semester.



The Fourth Year

In the FYUGP, the fourth year is at par with the first year of a Master's programme, as a student can directly take admission into the second year of a Master's programme after the successful completion of the FYUGP. In the fourth year, a student has to complete one compulsory paper on Research Methodology (REM) in the Semester 7, which is a 4-credit theory paper. The rest of courses will consist of Advanced Core Courses and a Dissertation depending on whether a student opts for a Degree (Honours) or Degree (Honours) with Research.

Instructions:

1. Students of Major course will have to select only one Minor subject.
2. Students of Major course will have to select subjects from AEC, MDC, SEC and VAC in the respective semesters as given in the curriculum.
3. Selection of applicants will be made as per merit.
4. A student desirous of offering a subject as Major Course must secure at least 50% marks in the concerned subject in HS level. The subject selection will be made on merit basis only.
5. Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD applicant will be maintained as per Govt. rules.
6. Subject choose at the time of Admission cannot be changed afterwards.

Examination and Evaluation:

- ❖ The pass marks in each paper is 40% of total marks in that paper (external + internal).
- ❖ A student who fails in one or more papers should repeat the papers by attending all the classes and by appearing for internal as well as external examinations at the next opportunity. A student shall get three chances for clearing the papers within six years from the date of admission to the degree programme.
- ❖ To pass in a course / paper, a student has to pass in both Internal Assessment and End Semester Examination separately.
- ❖ No student will be allowed to appear in the 'first and fifth' and 'second and sixth' semester examinations simultaneously.
- ❖ Internal Assessment marks will be 40% of a paper. The details of Internal Assessment marks are given below.

- ❖ Students have to upload scanned copies of Mark sheets, Certificates and all other relevant documents for the admission process. Authenticity of uploaded documents will be verified by college authority if needed.
- ❖ Students have to upload bank details including IFSC Code, Bank Name and Branch, mobile number and email id. to avail the benefit of any type of applicable govt. schemes.

- ❖ Registration and profile completion has to be done in the first phase. The necessary documents have to be uploaded in this process. The second phase of the admission includes form fill-up process and college selection part.
- ❖ Students can avail the Fee Waiver Scheme of Govt. of Assam as per the terms and conditions of the scheme. For detail guidelines of the Fee Waiver Scheme visit the college website.
- ❖ Fee Structure for admission into B.A. & B. Sc. 1st Semester will be uploaded in the college website.
- ❖ 75% of seats shall be reserved for the students of AHSEC as per Govt. Order.
- ❖ Candidates have to choose subjects as per subject groups from the instructions given in the Prospectus.
- ❖ Applications with incomplete documents and information will be summarily rejected by the admission committee.

Eligibility to Appear in the Examination:

- The students must have at least 75% attendance in lectures delivered in each of the subjects opted by them.
- Students are required to obtain the qualifying mark in aggregate of all subjects in the Sessional Examination.

- In case of serious illness, the leave application must be submitted within a week along with Medical Certificate. Otherwise, will not be granted for Medical Leave or any other leave



taken by the students. The leave only ensures that the student's name is not struck off and remains on the college rolls.

- Failing to fulfill any of the given conditions, the student will not be able to appear in the University Examination.
- Wearing prescribed uniform in the college is compulsory for all students.
- Use of Mobile Phone inside the college is subject to permission from the college authority.
- Appearing Sessional, Terminal, and Test Examinations is compulsory for all students.
